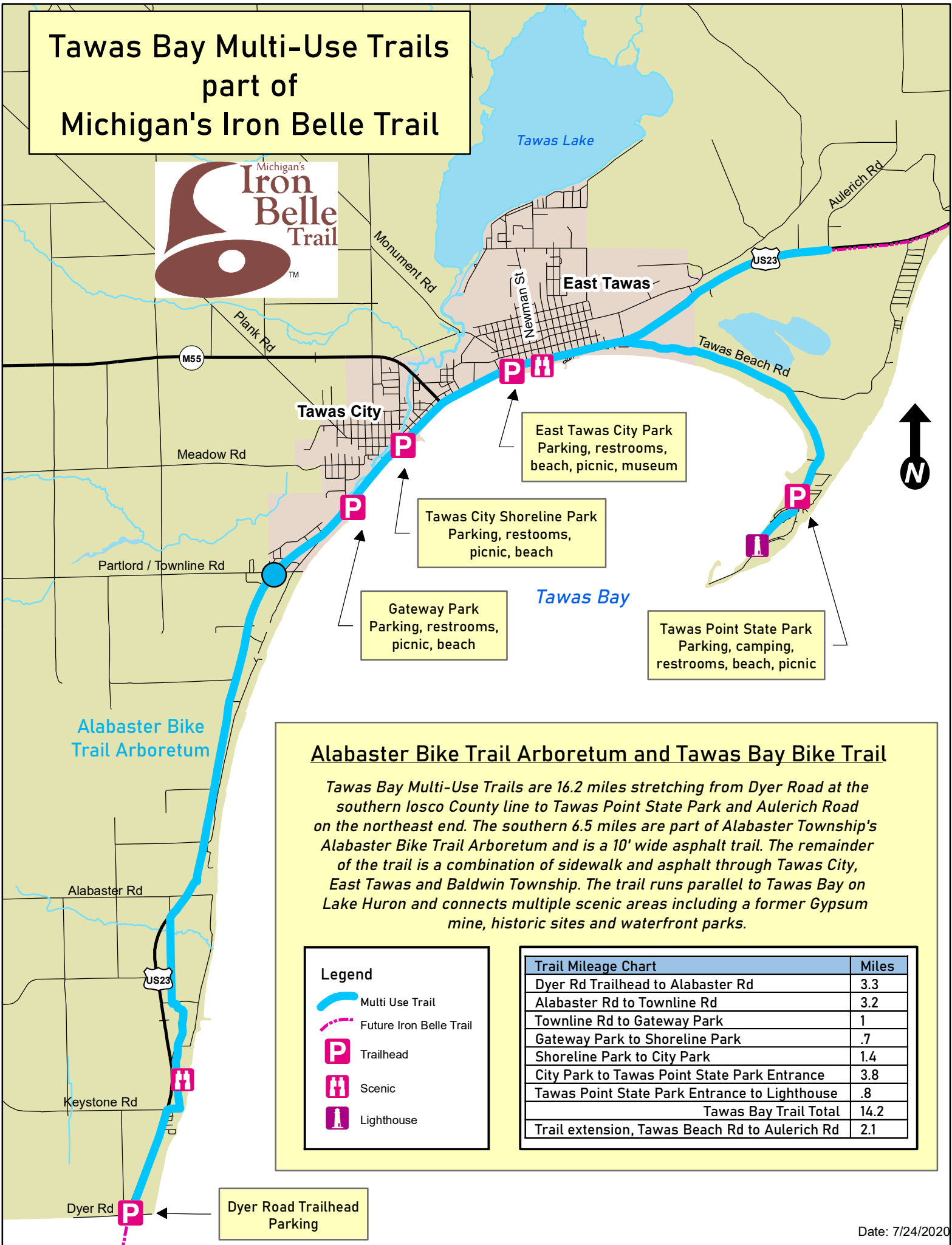


# Tawas Bay Multi-Use Trails part of Michigan's Iron Belle Trail

## Alabaster Bike Trail Arboretum and Tawas Bay Bike Trail

*Tawas Bay Multi-Use Trails are 16.2 miles stretching from Dyer Road at the southern Iosco County line to Tawas Point State Park and Aulerich Road on the northeast end. The southern 6.5 miles are part of Alabaster Township's Alabaster Bike Trail Arboretum and is a 10' wide asphalt trail. The remainder of the trail is a combination of sidewalk and asphalt through Tawas City, East Tawas and Baldwin Township. The trail runs parallel to Tawas Bay on Lake Huron and connects multiple scenic areas including a former Gypsum mine, historic sites and waterfront parks.*
