Watch Great Lakes freighters on their final voyages of the season, or take a trip aboard the River Queen paddleboat to witness the magnificent reflection

of Autumn foliage on the historic Au Sable River.

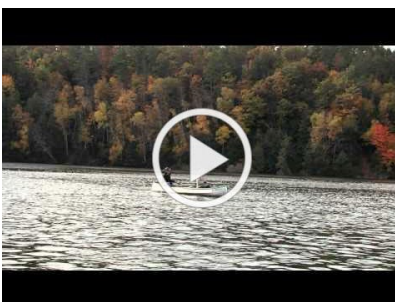


Nothing says fall like rustling leaves, snapping twigs and the click of your camera.

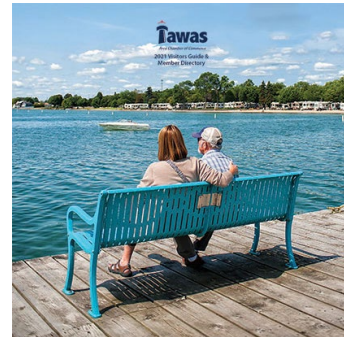
